

Cross Light

Prominent white lines stand out as distinctive shapes, against a backdrop of pure black pigment, in this intensely dynamic work by artist Johannes Boekhoudt. Strong strokes can be seen sweeping loosely along the edges of the piece itself, softening and giving balance to the obvious central contrast. Boekhoudt's deliberately constructed composition and gestural approach is quite illuminating and almost sculptural in feeling. There is much to be admired in this powerful articulation of abstract expressionism. -E.E. Jacks








